Edgebrook Covid Reminders

Happy New Year, Edgebrook Families!

As we begin a new year, we are also heading into new territory with the covid pandemic. Our community (and many others around us), have seen a large uptick in positive covid cases – among the vaccinated and unvaccinated. To continue keeping our membership and staff healthy during this time, we want to remind you of a few important policies and bring attention to procedures and notification expectations.

While the CDC did release updated guidance last week, the Washington Department of Health has not updated their guidance at the time of this email, and we are following WA DOH guidelines.

King County Department of Health and the **Washington Department of Health** have great resources available for how to decipher what your next steps are (testing/isolation/quarantine) depending on vaccination status and whether symptoms are present. Please visit their websites as information changes often.

A few key points for Edgebrook members:

- **As a member, you are responsible for communicating with whomever you played with regards to testing results.** If you test positive and have played at the club, you should notify any players you had close contact with who would have been exposed. Club staff does not need to be informed unless you had prolonged contact with a staff member during your time at the club.
- If you participated in a group class (Wimbledon, US Open, Skills and Drills, etc), flights, or junior program, you need to notify the club (Chauntelle@edgebrookclub.org) of a positive result. Members testing positive participating in group settings should expect an email notification to be sent from the club out to anyone who was on your court during the exposure date notifying them of increased risk. Names will not be used during these communications.
- **You are utilizing and participating at the club at your own risk.** While many of our members have not experienced covid exposure at the club, it is possible that with increased community rates that our club rates regarding positive covid results might also increase.

- Members remain required to wear masks at all times while not on the court and members are encouraged to wear masks while playing, if they are comfortable doing so.
- Any junior program participants who would like to take a “pause” from January junior program will be allowed to do so at no cost and still retain their place in the program. Please notify Debye (ebaccounts@edgebrookclub.org) if you want to exercise this option.
- There are no late cancellation penalties for courts at this time. If you aren't feeling well or are supposed to be in quarantine, please do not come to the club.

It is really important that we also do what we can to keep our EB staff healthy as well. We are VERY short staffed right now: *if we have multiple members on the staff out due to covid or covid exposure, we run the risk of potentially needing to limit club hours or close the club.* Please help us with this by limiting all contact with staff, do not linger in the reception area and take any conversations out of the building.
